

# Funding Assistance

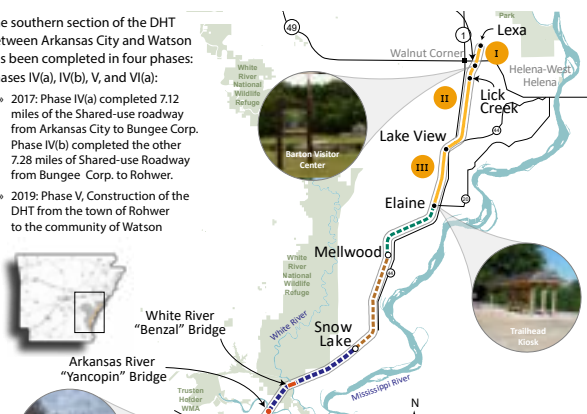


Funding sources range from federal RAISE grants and Transportation Alternatives Program funds to state, regional, local, and private sources. Alta staff can complete a range of tasks, from full-fledged preparation of the grant application to writing portions of the scope, providing mapping and graphics assistance, document review and quality control, and preliminary design.

*Alta staff have assisted jurisdictions across the country in winning over \$700 million in grant funding.*

The southern section of the DHT between Arkansas City and Watson has been completed in four phases: Phases IV(a), IV(b), V, and VI(a):

- 2017: Phase IV(a) completed 712 miles of the Shared-use roadway from Arkansas City to Bungee Corp. Phase IV(b) completed the other 7.28 miles of Shared-use Roadway from Bungee Corp. to Rohwer.
- 2019: Phase V, Construction of the DHT from the town of Rohwer to the community of Watson



Arkansas State Parks was awarded \$20.5 million in funding to construct the 35 miles Delta Heritage Trail following a successful RAISE grant application completed by Alta. Alta is leading the design of the historic rail-to-trail corridor.



Extreme heat is a serious public health issue in Los Angeles' Canoga Park community. Alta led an Urban Cooling feasibility study that directly supported the City's successful ATP Cycle 5 application - which awarded \$31M in funds (the largest award ever in the funding program's history).
