
Funding Assistance



Funding sources range from federal RAISE grants and Transportation Alternatives Program funds to state, regional, local, and private sources. Alta staff can complete a range of tasks, from full-fledged preparation of the grant application to writing portions of the scope, providing mapping and graphics assistance, document review and quality control, and preliminary design.

Alta staff have assisted jurisdictions across the country in winning over \$700 million in grant funding.



Arkansas State Parks was awarded \$20.5 million in funding to construct the 35 miles Delta Heritage Trail following a successful RAISE grant application completed by Alta. Alta is leading the design of the historic rail-to-trail corridor.



Extreme heat is a serious public health issue in Los Angeles' Canoga Park community. Alta led an Urban Cooling feasibility study that directly supported the City's successful ATP Cycle 5 application - which awarded \$31M in funds (the largest award ever in the funding program's history).
